Graceland NURSING Earn a Bachelor of Science Degree in Nursing

Requirements

Look for the Application Packet and open all the links.

Minimum CUM GPA of 2.75 of all college work OR a Prerequisite course GPA of 2.75 is required. Admission is competitive and higher GPA's are suggested.

Applicants will need 61 credit hours of general education and prerequisite courses. These must be completed by the end of the spring semester, prior to the start of the nursing program in June.

A satisfactory score must be achieved on the pre-admission proctored exam. The pre-admission exam will be offered at Graceland in August, September and January. Check the website for more information. Currently enrolled GU students on the Lamoni Campus are exempt from this requirement.

<u>Applicants must have English 1 and 2 and Speech with grades of A or B to be eligible for the program</u>. Applicants with a previous bachelor degree in another major will automatically meet this requirement. Those applicants with English and/or Speech grades lower than A or B will need to retake the courses before the June start date. The following courses must have been completed within the last 10 years: Chemistry, A & P, Microbiology and Nutrition.

Nursing Prerequisite Courses--Applicants must earn a minimum grade of "C", **preferably** <u>higher</u>. Performance in pre-requisite science courses is viewed seriously by the admission committee.

Application Process

Apply in the summer (or early fall), knowing that all required courses will be completed successfully by the end of the spring semester, to allow you to begin the nursing program the following June.

SEPTEMBER 30th is the DUE DATE for the application, transcripts and references, as well as the essay and scheduling the TEAS exam. <u>Applications **AFTER** the due date will still be considered.</u>
