



Richard J. 'Dick' Resch

n one of the coldest Homecoming Weekends in Graceland history, the families responsible for making the new Resch Science and Technology Hall possible gathered to celebrate its official dedication. On these pages you will find photos of just a few of the alumni and friends whose generosity to their alma mater will lead future generations of Graceland science, math and technology students to academic excellence and career success.

The dedication was a time for Resch Hall benefactors to meet current faculty and students, the beneficiaries, and view the cutting-edge classroom designs, ultra-modern laboratories and industry-standard equipment. It was a time for alumni friends from-the-1940s-to-the-present to reconnect in the beautiful new building, and experience the result of the old Platz-Mortimore Science Building 'Extreme Makeover.' Family of namesake Roy Mortimore were on hand to see the conference room honoring Roy and Gustav Platz.

With flurries in the frigid air, a ribbon cutting was held but the ceremony was moved inside. President John Sellars welcomed 300 guests and thanked donors, current students and faculty, Resch Hall leadership and advisory teams, architects, contractors and GU staff like Kurt Remmenga '80, our Facilities Services Director

who shepherded construction. The president also paid special tribute to "honored faculty from the past," who were present or represented by family.

Science and Math Division Chair Dan Pratt '81 spoke of how our programs are "built on the shoulders of

giants," and current science students Ryan Sheehy and Lauren Bevill said there is "something to cheer about" as they and fellow students begin to enjoy the new facility.

Graceland Board of Trustees Chair Ken McClain '79 recounted the birth of the project, when he became chair

of the Graceland Forever Capital Campaign, and he and his wife Cindy made the first significant gift to get the donor ball rolling. He noted that 842 families made gifts or pledges totaling \$15 million for the project. Six families' gifts of one million or more totaled nearly \$10 million. McClain credited Graceland legend Sherri Kirkpatrick '65 as "the driver and visionary of the campaign." He said, "Without her leadership the building would not have been built."

Kirkpatrick, newly retired after 30 years at GU, gave a stirring introduction of capstone donor Richard J. "Dick" Resch '58 who was on hand with his wife Sharon, and family members. Kirkpatrick added, "For decades to come careers will be shaped, decisions made and lives changed in Resch Hall. It is now a part of the life and legend of Graceland University."

Dick Resch is a kind, unassuming man, enormously successful and yet modest about his good fortune. He began by thanking all those involved in the project and noted that this year's Homecoming theme, Creating: The Future, was especially appropriate. "Graceland is committed to future generations of students. We are all, indeed, helping create the future of Graceland."

Resch reminisced a bit about "being a scared kid from the Twin Cities 53 years ago" when he arrived at GU. "I wondered, will I succeed in life? Well, thanks to a lot of help, like my friend and college roommate Dan Kelley ('58), I made it through." Dan and his wife Sharon were present.

"Thank you Graceland for providing the foundation of my education," he said. "On behalf of my wife and family, a sincere thanks for providing us this opportunity to assist future generations in their educational endeavors."

Trustee Emeritus and faithful Graceland friend Dan

Waite '48, offered a prayer of dedication. Dan and his wife Alice Carlile '47 Waite provided a significant gift to the project. "Thanks to all who gave their very best," he said. "And thanks to the inspired faculty who will share vistas of hope and learning in this sacred scientific space."◆







The Ross family came together with 100 guests to both celebrate the beautiful, little school's completion, and to honor family matriarch Emma Jean "Vicki" McVicker '50 Ross. Many families made Resch Hall possible, including the Ross family. You may remember that the children of Vicki and Donald R. Ross, Jr. '48 contributed a million dollars in their parents' honor. Don passed away in 1990. Subsequent family gifts were also made.

From the beginning it was Vicki's vision and dream to bring back to life the dilapidated, century-old school near Leon where she attended as a little girl. Vicki is a member of the Graceland Board of Trustees and she called upon fellow trustee Orman Brooner '53 (and his St. Joseph, MO construction company) to restore the school and ultimately move it to the Welcome Center. "He brought it to life and made it new," she said.

Poignantly, sometimes near tears, always her joyful self, Vicki shared with those gathered the long process of acquiring the school – she and daughter Julie Ross '84 Dixon discovered it during a trip from their home in Pennsylvania to their southern-Iowa roots a number of years ago;

Graceland Shines Brighter Because of our 2009 Alumni Award Recipients

he Graceland Alumni Association presented their awards at the 10th Annual Alumni Emeriti & Awards Banquet at Homecoming 2009. **Bonita**



Booth received the Honorary Alumni Award, given only periodically to exceptional friends of the university. Though she has been a steadfast servant of Graceland for more than 30 years, Bonita is perhaps best known as the architect of a complex and comprehensive student recruiting and retention program that has served Graceland for two

decades. Bonita served as Director of Counseling and Placement, but at the request of then-President Barbara Higdon, Bonita gave up career counseling in 1984 to become GU's Dean of Admissions and later VP for Enrollment Management, becoming Graceland's first female VP. Her tremendous efforts in getting her colleagues on the "retention band wagon," and her work helping found the Honors and Chance programs, enabled numerous additional students to attend and graduate from Graceland.

Orman '53 and Colleen Brooner received the Graceland Award of Recognition. Their love for and service to Graceland has touched the lives of innumerable students. They are true Gracelanders. Orman, a member of our Board of Trustees, has generously provided the services of their company, Brooner Construction, of St. Joseph, Missouri, for work on a number of projects at Graceland, most recently by restoring and then moving a century-old school house from near Leon to the site behind the Graceland Amish Country Store. It is

a showplace in the area and a popular site for visitors and area school children. The Brooners also donated the construction work to create the new offices in the MSC for our Sandage Center and Students in Free Enterprise. The Brooners' love and support of their "SIFE kids," as Colleen calls them, has been tremendous. They have made notable financial contributions to SIFE and they have literally traveled with the team around the country and the world, even to Paris in 2006 for the World Championships. They also made significant gifts toward the extreme makeover of Resch Science and Technology Hall. They established and support the Brooner Scholarship Endowment and our general scholarship fund, both of which further the goal of bringing additional students to Graceland.


The Distinguished Service Award went to **Sherri '65** and **Jac '62 Kirkpatrick** for living as "distinguished ser-

vants" to thousands of children and young adults around the globe, and for serving the Graceland community with love and affection for decades. Sherri joined the Graceland faculty in 1980. During her leadership of the nursing program, student enrollments grew

from a low of nine in 1986, when she assumed the division chair position, to over 3,000 in the early 1990s. She was instrumental in developing Graceland's first distance education program, first master's program, and first administrative unit organized as a School rather than a Division. She helped with the design of the state-of-the-art facility that became Graceland's Independence Campus. More recently she has served Graceland as dean, provost, acting vice president for academic affairs, vice president for institutional advancement and vice president for the Independence Campus. Jac was called to be an apostle in 1988 and spent 20 years on the Council of Twelve, leading church efforts in Africa, Asia, Europe, the British Isles and parts of the U.S. He helped found and develop the WorldService Corps, which has placed over 300 young adult volunteers in cross-cultural learning experiences around the world. Sherri and Jac are both now retired, but that means that they will be busier than ever. Together they will now devote themselves to HealthEd Connect, the Graceland-affiliated NGO they created to empower women and children in some of the poorest regions in Sub-Sahara Africa, Nepal and India through evidencebased health care, education and advocacy groups.

He Followed his Dad to the Running Life he Loves

Teil Grundman was in 5th grade when his dad, 1981 Graceland alumnus Mark Grundman, decided to get in shape. Dad started running and Neil tagged along. In the old photo above you can see Mark and Neil (then 12-years old) finishing their first 10K road race together in Port Huron, MI.

"It was agonizing at first," Neil now admits, "but I knew I was hooked on running." Neil's mom, Donna Muir '81 Grundman, gave us the photo. She remembers Mark had to slow down in that race to let Neil keep up. Wow, have times changed.

Neil, 21, just became a Cross Country All-American for GU for the second straight year, finishing 13th in a field of 323 of the best distance runners in the country. It was a cold, wet day November 21st at the NAIA National CC Run in Vancouver, WA. He ran the 8K in 25:30, just a minute off the winning time, and he says he didn't have a great run. "Sometimes you just know," he said, his infectious smile slipping through. "There are good runs and there are great runs. This was a good run."

Neil is the first CC All-American in Graceland history and he is only a junior. He is rewriting GU's track-

distance and CC record books as he goes. And, he is one of the nicest guys you would ever want to meet. You learn quickly when you talk to Neil that CC is

a passion, but not his total life. With his speed he could have gone to big universities on great scholarships. He chose Graceland. He says,

"It has been one of the best decisions of my life." His brother, parents, aunts and uncles, are all alumni, and Neil is a Community of Christ member, but even those were not his primary reasons. He loves the smallness of GU, the feeling of community we all relish here. He appreciates the small class sizes and credits teachers like Chemistry Professor Brad Mercer for "personal attention that helped me really understand."

He credits CC Head Coach Kent Allshouse '84 and Assistant Coach Danny Alvarado '01 for "great team-coaching" that has taught him patience, and so much more. "They bring me down to Earth. I tend to get overanxious." There's that smile again. He calls the GU CC

course Allshouse and friends carved out of nothing a few years ago "one of the best I've run on, a credit to Graceland." And Neil is quick to thank all his teammates, including freshmen Ahmed Khalif (his training buddy) and Jami Ruckman, who both recorded respectable times at the na-

tional run. Coach Allshouse had nothing but praise for his three outstanding runners. "Coach's goal now is to recruit an even better team for next year," said Neil.

When Neil leans back in his chair and really talks about running you feel like you're there with him, flying across the sandy shoreline of Lake Huron where he has trained all his life. It is as if his feet leave the ground, he says. He doesn't even feel like he's running. "I am moving through the air, taking in the beauty of my surroundings, thinking about the ecology of where I am. To me,

that is the beauty of running." Locally, he likes to train along the gorgeous, natural trails surrounding Nine Eagles State Park near Lamoni. It is no surprise, then, to learn that Neil is studying ecology at GU and he hopes to work with the U.S. Forestry Service upon graduation. "My perfect job would be a ranger at Glacier National Park." What better place to lift off the ground and fly through nature.

Second Straight Elite 8 Appearance for Women's Soccer

his year brought more of what's come to be expected from the Graceland women's soccer team. Spending much of the season ranked in the top 10 nationally, the Lady Jackets geared themselves up for another strong run through the conference and into the NAIA National Tournament in early December.

After cruising through the regular season with an overall record of 15-1-2 (their only loss coming at the hands of the #1 team in the country Lindsey Wilson) the Jackets headed into the HAAC tournament as the #1 seed looking to clinch an automatic berth to the NAIA National Tournament. As had been the case all year, GU dominated the opposition shutting out both Lindenwood and Baker 2-0 and won the championship.

After clinching their spot in the NAIA Opening Round in Lamoni at the Rasmussen Soccer Field ('the Razz'), the last team holding the Jackets back from a trip to Alabama was undefeated Dakota Wesleyan University. They would prove to be no match for the Jackets however, as Graceland scored two first-half goals and pulled away in the second half for the 4-1 win, advancing to the NAIA final destination in Decatur, AL.

The women's trip to nationals began late Friday night, November 27th in Liberty, MO at the home of GU soccer boosters and alumni Jim '78 and Pam Smith '77 Ash. The Ash's have provided amazing support to the women's soccer team over the past several years and are truly great fans. After a night of rest, the team awoke Saturday morning for an early flight to Nashville. A two hour drive into Decatur made for a long Saturday of travel and excitement and anticipation were building.

Upon arriving in Alabama, the focused Yellowjackets began preparing for their next opponent. Graceland was seeded #12 in the tournament and set to face William Carey University of Hattiesburg, MS. The Lady Cougars were ranked #3 in the national rankings and seeded #5 in the tournament. After practicing Saturday, Sunday and Monday there was only one thought in the focused minds of the Yellowjackets: a win over William Carey.

In a game that mirrored most of the season for Graceland, both teams played to a 0-0 tie in the first half. As was the case for most of the season, the second half was all Graceland. Junior midfielder Shay Eskridge



(Rowlett, TX) got the Jacket scoring started almost immediately in the second half. Eskridge drilled a beautiful strike into the upper 90 from outside the 18 box allowing the William Carey keeper no chance at a save. The goal not only gave the Jackets a 1-0 lead but opened the flood gates for the rest of the half. Just over three minutes after the Eskridge goal junior All-American Chelsea Phillips (Granada Hills, CA) scored on a rebound from a shot Gisella Arietta (Valledupar, Colombia) banged off the left post. Karina Vega (Ascuncion, Paraguay) and Phillips would each tack on goals for Graceland and William Carey would score a late goal. It wasn't nearly enough in the Jackets dominant 4-1 win.

After the win, the Lady Jackets had little time to celebrate knowing they would face Azusa Pacific University in 22 hours. Still, they found time to enjoy some famous (and delicious I might add) Bob Gibson BBQ. The meal was generously provided thanks to Graceland alumna Beverly Johnson '68 Scherer. She lives in Huntsville, not far from Decatur, and she supported the Jackets generously during their stay. The ladies were treated the night





before their Elite 8 game to spaghetti served and donated by the Decatur Community of Christ congregation. The support offered by so many in Decatur during the ladies' stay was remarkable. Then it was off to bed in preparation for the biggest game of their season.

I'm like a Jackson Pollock painting," says Claudia Horton, Ph.D., RN, and Dean of Graceland's School of Nursing since 2008. "I splatter here, and then I splatter there." She's referring to her tendency to talk fast and shift topics often, but the simile works on multiple levels. Like abstract expressionist painter Jackson Pollock, Horton combines experience, technique, and vision in her work. Unlike Pollock, Horton is accessible to everyone – but only if you can keep up. "I'm just wired for moving fast," says Horton, "I want to do it all."

You might argue that Horton has already done it all. Her broad experience in the nursing field makes her ideal for guiding the nursing programs' growth in the wake of a rapidly changing profession and increasingly complex health care system. Hospitals are raising their degree requirements for both new and experienced nurses. The economy is shifting hiring trends. Technology is causing rapid change in best practices for teaching. Horton is ready.

Although Horton started as a key punch operator right after high school, she heard a greater calling. "I wanted something more compelling, more meaningful

in my life," says Horton. "I was in nursing club in high school, and my grandmother was a practical nurse. She had an influence on me."

The first in her family to go to college, Horton became a licensed practical nurse (LPN) in 1975 and a registered nurse (RN) in 1981. Her early work at the Independence Sanitarium and Hospital lead quickly to a Bachelor of Science in Nursing (BSN) degree. "A lot of nurses at 'The San' were Graceland grads, and they talked about the program," says Horton. "They suggested I go there."

After completing her BSN at Graceland in 1986 (magna cum laude, no less), Horton spent the next six years as a critical care nurse, education coordinator, and nurse recruiter at Research Medical Center in Kansas City, Missouri. In 1989, she returned to school, this time to the University of Missouri-Kansas City, and earned her Master of Science degree in Nursing (MSN). "My transcript is how I keep track of my life," she says. "For a while, I prided myself on having graduation parties every six years."

Horton held her most recent graduation party in 2006, when she earned her Ph.D. from UMKC's Interdisciplinary Doctoral Program in Urban Leadership and Policy Studies in Education. "The emphasis of the program was on administration in higher education, but my research was in nursing," says Horton. "At that time, I was associate dean of Graceland's BSN nursing program, so it fit nicely with what I was doing."

Her call to education is as strong as her call to nursing. "I'm a life-long learner," she says. "I really like being in school and the stimulation of being in the classroom. I thrive on that."

Challenge 1: Nursing shortage? Not exactly.

"Nurses aren't retiring right now because of the economy," Horton says. "Some are even switching from part time to full time." As a result, new nursing graduates across the country are having trouble finding jobs for the first time in years. "Hospitals are hiring only about 50 percent of the new graduates they used to," Horton says. She is quick to point out, however, that 100 percent of Graceland's 2009 BSN graduates found positions.

"However, the job market is still strong for nurse practitioners." Graceland's Master of Nursing program is already helping associate and baccalaureate graduates become either family nurse practitioners (FNP) or nurse educators. FNPs provide a broader range of health care services than RNs without an advanced degree, including diagnosing illnesses and prescribing medication. Nurse educators become clinical educators in hospitals or faculty in nursing schools. Both MSN tracks offer three options for completing the degree: accelerated (24 to 28 months), full-time (32 to 36 months), and part-time (44 to 52 months).

Sure Hand Guides School of Nursing

Without an advanced degree, Horton knows that nurses can struggle to get ahead. "I went back to school time and time again because opportunities required a certain degree," she says, "and I wanted those opportunities."

Challenge 2: BSN in 10

Forget advancement — sometimes nurses need a degree just to get in the door. Hospitals are more likely to hire nurses with a BSN or higher, Horton says, because recent studies — including some published in the *Journal of Nursing Administration and the Journal of the American Medical Association* — indicate that the higher the number of BSN graduates on staff, the lower the hospital's patient death rates.

As a result of these studies, New York and New Jersey introduced state bills in 2009 that would require nurses to complete their BSN within 10 years of earning their RN licensure — a trend Horton calls "BSN in 10." In the federal government, BSN in 10 isn't just a trend, it's a fact. The Department of Veterans Affairs has required a baccalaureate degree since 1995 for any registered nurse advancing beyond an entry level position, and the U.S. Army, Navy and Air Force require a BSN for all active duty RNs. Horton supports these standards. "Research shows that there are better outcomes when nurses have more education."

Currently licensed RNs who want to complete their degree can choose between two programs at Graceland: RN-BSN, in which students earn a bachelor's degree, and RN-MSN, which offers both a BSN and an MSN at an accelerated rate. The School of Nursing designed these online programs with working nurses in mind: they can live, learn and complete their clinical anywhere in the United States. Horton is proud of the online programs' quality. "Some people think online programs are easy," she says. "There might be some that are, but not Graceland. We are not a diploma mill."

Challenge 3: Technology isn't cheap. Or easy.

High-fidelity patient simulation labs, the latest in learning technology for nurses, use life-sized, computerized mannequins and real-world clinical scenarios to help students practice their evaluation and communication skills in a safe environment. Penn State has one. Duke has one. Horton wants Graceland to have one, too.

The School of Nursing recently applied for a \$192,000 grant from private foundations to help fund the simulation lab, including a mannequin, medical equipment for the different scenarios and faculty training. The Truman Heartland Community Foundation, School of Nursing and Sam's Club have already contributed to the fund. "We have a ways to go," says Horton, "but we will get there."

Nursing students can't stop at using technology to learn health care — they also have to learn to use health-

care technology. "Most new students know how to use computers and MP3 players," says Horton, "but not how to incorporate technology into their practice." Professors must teach them to use medical devices that monitor glucose levels, display electrocardiogram tracing, and administer continuous epidural medication. In their clinical practicums, students learn to enter clinical data in computerized flow sheets and on electronic medical records.

What's next?

Horton knows that the School of Nursing is positioned to meet these challenges because of the women who came before her. Margaret McKevitt created Graceland's BSN program in 1969. Sherri Kirkpatrick, Ph.D., RN, FAAN, established Graceland's distance nursing program, one of the first in the United States, in 1987. Karen Fernengel, Ph.D., RN, created the Master of Science in Nursing degree in 1995, and Kathy Ballou, Ph.D., RN, organized a task force in 2006 to consider the viability of a Doctor of

Nursing Practice (DNP) program that Horton hopes to launch in a few years.


Yes, there's a great foundation, but Horton is looking ahead. "We're continuing to expand online programs, including our nurse practitioner program," says Horton. "We're also working on



the business plan for the Doctor of Nursing Practice and hope to offer our first DNP course in 2011."

There are days, though, when Horton misses practicing nursing. "I really, really loved being at the bedside and connecting with patients," she says. "I miss that. I do." But Horton knows she contributes in other ways. "I often wonder how far you can be from the bedside and still consider yourself a nurse," she says. "Nursing is bigger than the bedside – it can be conducting research in the National Institutes of Health or making policy in the legislature. It is evolving as we mature and find where we belong."

Brent Wouters' Mission: Selling "Time Machines"

ook at the focused, no-nonsense expression of the man in this photo. He is a man on a mission. And note the breathtaking Vison SF50 jet behind him, the latest marvel from general aviation industry leader Cirrus Aircraft of Duluth, Minnesota. Sometimes a photo tells a story.

This photo tells the story of 1988 Graceland alumnus Brent Wouters, President and CEO of Cirrus. With focused leadership and no-nonsense decision making, Brent has led Cirrus in an aggressive challenge during one of the worst economic downturns in history. Few industries were more negatively impacted. Tough decisions included downsizing, restructuring, reducing costs and streamlining. The result is a leaner, stronger Cirrus Aircraft, a half-billion-dollar global contender in the competitive world of selling "Time Machines."

The SF50 jet is in development at Cirrus, poised to pioneer the emerging personal and light jet market. It is the Cirrus SR20 and SR22 piston aircraft, however, that have driven the company's rapid growth – 5,000 planes sold in 50 countries in the last decade. The sleek, fast SR22 has been the world's best selling plane for seven years.

These are aircraft that expand the clock, if you will, for Cirrus' personal and corporate owners. "Business is about getting in front of your customers," Brent says, "meeting them eye-to-eye, being in a lot of places in a short amount of time." Cirrus' BMWs of the sky, as he calls them, are affordable, easy to fly, very fast and the safest planes around. Visually, they are stunning. Go to cirrusaircraft. com and take a look. Most importantly, he says, they dramatically increase productivity of business leaders. Suddenly, you are not gone for three days. You leave after breakfast. You are home for dinner.

Brent, 44, joined Cirrus in 2002 as Executive VP and CFO. He became CEO in 2008. He is responsible for day-to-day operations but he too must get out there, out "in front" of his customers. He spends 90 percent of his time growing new business. He flies a Cirrus 'time machine' to make that happen. The best result, perhaps, is that he is home in Duluth for weekends and time to spend with his wife Shawn and sons Albert, 13, and Andrew, 11.

Brent grew up in Lamoni, the youngest of four sons of Graceland legend Ralph $^{\prime}70$ and Lois Farren

'77 Wouters. Ralph was VP for GU Business Services for 25 years. He was, as you might guess, a tough, no-nonsense leader "who made the hard-but-correct decisions and guided Graceland through tough times," according to current VP for Business and Administrative Services, Janice Tiffany '83, a 29-year GU employee. Brent acknowledges that he operates a lot like his dad. "I learned you can't just save your way to prosperity. You have to sell your way out of economic challenges." Ralph and Lois live in the Kansas City area and Brent often flies his family down from Duluth for quick visits. His brothers are Reed '83, Todd '85 and Ross'86.

Before Cirrus, Brent was CFO for International Payment Services, a venture-backed payment processing company. He also served as an equity research analyst for Salomon Smith Barney. His aviation experience includes 2 years as an Aircraft Engineer, four years developing and testing flight simulators for Delta Air Lines and time as an information technology consultant assisting Lockheed Martin on the F22 fighter jet program. He holds an MBA from Georgia State University, an MS in Aerospace Engineering from Iowa State and a BA in Math and Physics from Graceland.

It was what he learned in science and math classes at Graceland, Brent says, that drove his career. "My GU and ISU technical degrees gave me instant credibility." But science was not enough. It is what he learned with a liberal arts education that has driven his life. He read history and literature, and he learned to write and to deal with different cultures and personalities. "I didn't realize it at the time, but I was learning to express myself. And it is communication that has helped me excel in business around the world. If you can't communicate effectively, the power of your message is lost."

"What is my advice to current Graceland students? Pay attention to your liberal arts education, and to the cultural influences around campus. It will help guide your life in ways you can't yet imagine."

Alma Blair Writes a Brief History of Herald Hall

raceland Professor Emeritus Alma Blair '49 has written a short history of old Herald Hall, the publishing house that became a dormitory to both Graceland women and men students at different times between 1920 and 1971. Herald Hall was demolished in 2006 to make room for the new Lamoni High School and gymnasium.

Limited copies of the book, *Herald Hall*, 1907 - 2006, *A Brief History by Alma Blair*, are being printed by the Lamoni Community Schools. It was a requirement from the State of Iowa Historical Preservation Office when the building was razed. Graceland

has reserved 30 copies to make available to alumni. They are \$10 each. If you are interested email *Horizons* editor Randy Meline at: meline@graceland.edu. They will be provided on a first-come, first-served basis. There may be subsequent copies available through the Lamoni Schools. The booklet is about 20 pages long and includes photos and footnotes.

Alma refers to Herald Hall as one of "those special places" in Lamoni that holds diverse memories for many residents and students over the years, a place that was "central to Lamoni's beginnings and prosperity." Alma is central to Lamoni's connec-

tion with history. The consummate historian and Graceland legend, who taught generations of students about Latter Day Saint history, Religious Education, Western and World Civilization, now writes small, periodic pieces for the Lamoni Chronicle about curiosities of Lamoni history.

Alma helped found and was president of the John Whitmer Associa-



tion. He trained hundreds of summer guides at Nauvoo. His films, articles and research established him as a top church historian and he oversaw restoration of Lamoni's historic Liberty Hall, where he still serves as a volunteer.

Horizons interviewed a number of Graceland alumni who lived at Herald Hall, "Herald Angels" as they called themselves, for a special section in the summer 2007 issue. You can read their stories online at 'Alumni & Friends' on GU's Web site. Many past issues of Horizons are available at the site.

In closing, Alma notes that, "The building served Lamoni well for almost 100 years. Hopefully, this tribute will help it survive in historical memory for many years to come."

Graceland and Community Gather to Hear Darfur Survivor


r. Halima Bashir, a survivor of the genocide in Darfur, Sudan, and recipient of the 2009 International Peace Prize from the Community of Christ, spoke to an audience of 300 students and community members October 26 in The Shaw Center for the Performing Arts.

Audience members traveled from around the region to hear her personal story: life in her village before the civil war; terror during the genocide; and her efforts to draw attention to and provide assistance to the victims. Dr. Bashir has written a book of her experiences, Tears of the Desert: A Memoir of Survival in Darfur. Ishagi Mekki, Executive Secretary of Darfur Victims Organization for Relief and Rehabilitation, followed Dr. Bashir with information about the current social and political situation in Darfur. A video, Voices from Darfur (www.voicesfromdarfur.org) was shown to illustrate the stark reality of the ongoing tragedy.

As with most presentations, Dr. Bashir asked for questions when she finished. Unlike most presentations, none came. Her quiet, somewhat halting delivery allowed the audience time to consider the full meaning of the events she had survived. It took time to process her horrific descriptions. After Mr. Mekki's presentation, the questions began to flow. It was a powerful evening for Graceland students and area residents. Dr. Bashir made it clear that the story of Darfur has not ended.

Andrew Bolton of the Community of Christ served as primary contact with Graceland and Parris Watts, GU's VP for Academic Affairs and Dean of Faculty, provided administrative support for this remarkable event. Director of Government Relations Tom Morain helped secure Dr. Bashir's last-minute visa. Claudia Horton, Dean of our School of Nursing, provided transportation for Dr. Bashir. Writing Center secretary Lisa Silver provided logistical support, including child care for Dr. Bashir's children.

It is our hope that events such as this can become a regular part of Graceland's First Year Experience program.◆

Graceland Mourns Death of Student Blake Kouri



raceland senior Blake Kouri died tragically while hunting October 15 near Leonard, Missouri. An avid outdoorsman, Blake was reported missing when he did not return from his deer blind and his body was found the following morning.

Blake, 24, was the son of Richard and Michelle Kouri of Colorado Springs. His brother Grant Kouri is a 2006 Graceland graduate and he is currently working with the Peace Corps in Tonga. Blake had been a student at GU since January 2006. He was a member of Closson House. According to a friend, Blake was a quiet and very caring individual. Friends said his smile was contagious.

A prayer vigil held at the Roy Cheville Chapel was well attended by students, faculty and staff. "The death of one of our students affects us all," said Dean of Students Tom Powell. "We sincerely mourn Blake's passing." Professor of Religion Priscilla Eppinger had Blake in her Ecological Theology class and remembers him as "...a true lover of the natural world. He caught on and understood things quickly. I will remember Blake because he was unfailingly respectful and polite."

Blake worked part time with Gregg Pattison, a Private Lands Biologist with the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service who has an office at Graceland. "Blake brought a real passion for natural resources and nature to his work. Remembering Bob Farnham



obert "Bob" Farnham '80, a 24-year veteran staff member and professor at Graceland, passed away on August 22 after a long battle with brain cancer. He was 51.

Bob had a huge impact on Graceland since arriving as Director of Information Technology in 1985. He steered us toward a networked operation and helped ensure that Graceland was among the first schools connected to the Iowa Communications Network (ICN), the first statewide fiber optics network of its kind. This gave Graceland students in the 90's spectacular Internet speeds that were the envy of their peers at other colleges.

He approached cancer the way he did everything else, with an optimistic outlook about the future. He joked about his condition by feeling for a pulse and saying "I'm still here." In 2005 he finished a second Master's Degree and was granted tenure, so his next move seemed an incredible leap of faith. He was granted a Ph.D. fellowship in Bioinformatics at Iowa State, and took a two year sabbatical to complete courses for his doctorate. In April 2009 he completed his third Master's degree, in Bioinformatics.

Bob became a faculty member in computer science in 2000. He was a HAM radio devotee,



He married Lynda Susan Heath '80 on August 4, 1979 in Mitchell, Ontario, Canada. They had three children: Adam Robert '05, Corinne Michelle and Erin Ashley '07.

I have special memories of Bob as Scoutmaster when our sons were scouting age and I was an assistant. Bob believed that scheduling a camping event was, in effect, a promise to the kids who looked forward to it. Even in the nastiest of weather, with few participants, Bob never cancelled. His enthusiasm when faced with more challenging circumstances made these the favorite camping events for the boys. Bob was one of the most affirming adults, especially with young people under his guidance. His response to someone's contribution was almost always an enthusiastic "Excellent!"

I happened to visit Bob the day before he passed to return some personal effects. I told him how the newly remodeled Resch Science and Technology Hall was progressing. In a whisper he said but one word, "Excellent!"

Reconnecting with alumni friends was wonderful, as was the chance to meet some of the amazing OI field staff who fight the poverty families in poor communities live with. I hope you'll allow me to thank them here with a letter I wrote on the plane ride home.

To my dearest new friends at Outreach Philippines: Felee, Ami, Leizl, Emily, Val, Nancy, Leslie Jr., Krizza and Rose, I am sad to leave you, your beautiful country and your special people. My airlines must think the teary passenger in seat 30J is a touch disturbed, crying into his Blackberry. And indeed I am disturbed; rightly so. Disturbed, and oddly comforted, by the lessons you taught me over the past few days.

You opened a new world to me this week in the land of gecko monsters and "cool" days where the temperature hits 90 degrees. You helped me discover a new room in my heart – a room where people are hungry and poor but where they also live with history and dimension and hope. Scripture tells us that when we minister to the poor, we are ministering to God. It is not "as if" we are ministering to God; we are, indeed, in those times, in the presence of the Divine. This week we truly encountered God on the holy village grounds of Pulong Visaya and Kabulihan and Sapang Bato – in dirt-floored huts and brass-band shelters. Smiling faces were missing teeth but brightest smiles cracked open our city-dweller hearts and God flowed out – Who knew that at your line.

Who knew that at your knee this week I would learn that I too am among the world's poor? Am I held captive by brand-centric buying and deodorized Western smells? Do I worship at the alter of conspicuous consumption and frigid gadgetry? Am I poor in knowledge of the human spirit and God's everlasting presence there? Am I crippled by my ignorance of the causes of poverty and the desperate circumstances faced by the world's poor? Am I captive to creature comforts and professional accolades? Am I sick with drunkenness on never-ending sources of food and water and toiletries and opportunities? Yes, perhaps I am.

While I thought I was ministering to the poor with you this week, in fact we were all ministering to each other. Through our new relationships we discovered strength and compassion and hope, taking turns being student and teacher, preacher and congregant, hungry and fed. Within us all, the Divine heart beats like a steady drum, calling us to join the march toward justice and equality. This week, with my ears cleared by your words and actions, I could hear the drums of Heaven more clearly. How urgent their sounds. How mighty the drum sticks in your skillful hands.

You are making an impressive contribution in the struggle against the dehumanizing tragedy that is poverty. So thank you for the food, for the lessons, for the walk you walk so beautifully each day as you empower others to begin to have choices, to chart their courses like I chart mine anew having met you and them. From home, I will advocate for you. I will advocate for the poor like we met this week, villager and self, and I will live my life differently having witnessed the work you do and the lives you touch.

Juhnke Fulbright to China Focuses on American Culture

t's difficult not to think of Eric Juhnke as a chip off the old block when you learn some of what he was lecturing on as a Fulbright Scholar this year in China. The old block, of course, is Eric's dad, History Professor Emeritus Bill Juhnke, who retired in 2009 after 35 years of inspiring Graceland students on topics like the Civil Rights Movement and Dr. Martin Luther King.

Eric '92 taught American Culture and Society at Guangdong University of Foreign Studies (GDUFS) in Guangzhou Spring semester. At his first campus-wide lecture, 200 students and faculty gathered at 3 p.m. on the Friday of a holiday weekend to hear him talk about, that's right, the Civil Rights Movement and Dr. Martin Luther King. The elder Juhnke said simply, "I am a proud dad."

Eric is an Associate Professor of History and Department Chair at Briar Cliff University in Sioux City, Iowa. He and his wife, Jodi Glennie '92 Juhnke, an elementary school teacher, and their two daughters, Megan, 8, and Lily 5, immersed themselves in the culture and society of China as Eric returned the favor to his students at GDUFS where as a member of the Department of English Language and Culture he delivered campus-wide lectures on topics, including "American Music and War" and "Frontier Myths v. Reality." Eric reported that his students were inquisitive, enthusiastic, and spoke excellent English. "We really bonded," said Eric. "I have maintained contact with several since my return to the U.S." The Fulbright grant provided us "a terrific opportunity to experience another culture, learn alternative perspectives, meet new people and visit a beautiful country."

The Juhnkes felt lucky to be in Guangzhou, a city of 10 million people located about 75 miles northwest of Hong Kong. Isolated in a northern suburb next to a mountain and scenic recreational area, GDUFS did not allow easy access to the rest of the city. Jodi explained that it was "67 steps up to their fourth-floor apartment, and it took a 20-30-minute walk, then a cab or bus ride" for offcampus shopping or restaurants. The family took it all in stride. Even Lily learned to hail a taxi. They visited local sites and events, including a Buddhist temple, international circus, safari park, and dragon boat races and enjoyed dining on dim sum, a regional cuisine, at various restaurants. "The size and frenetic pace of the city was amazing" said Eric. After a dicey crossing of an eight-<mark>lane street one day with a mob of pedestrians, Megan</mark> exclaimed, "I can't believe they do this every day!"

Jodi was recruited to teach English part-time at a university-affiliated elementary school. She also worked



as a long-term substitute teacher at a nearby international school – daughter Megan was in the class. The girls enjoyed interacting with students and teachers from all over the world. Like a mini-United Nations, Megan's class included representatives from Korea, Japan, Finland, Australia, Czech Republic, China, Thailand, Jordan and India.

When not in school or exploring Guangzhou, the Juhnkes walked on the Great Wall, got splashed at Huangguoshu Falls in Guizhou Province and played in the sand on Hainan Island, known as China's Hawaii. Guest lecture trips afforded Eric other sightseeing opportunities, including a tour of Xian's Terra Cotta Warriors. The family also had the chance to serve as tour guide for visitors Darin Booth '92 and Carita and Bill, Eric's mom and dad. "The girls loved exploring Hong Kong with 'Uncle' Darin," said Eric of his former Graceland roommate's visit. "We benefited greatly from their China experience," Bill reported. "They gave us an extraordinary encounter with Chinese culture and everyday life, the girls coaching us on our Chinese all the while."

After such a wonderful experience, it was a bitter sweet return home. "There were still so many places we wanted to visit and things for us to do," said Eric. "We had made several friends, felt confident navigating Guangzhou, and our language skills were improving — and then we had to leave." The family plans to return to China in the future. Next time they hope to stay even longer.

After that guest lecture on the Civil Rights Movement and Martin Luther King, Eric was approached by a student who asked how he could use civil disobedience to gain greater democracy in China. That was a "Wow!" moment for the Fulbright scholar and one that would delight his father. Chip off the old block, indeed. •

Venerable MSC Must Make Way for 21st Century Students

t has been 60 years since the university skate club, the 'Graceland Holy Rollers,' held their first skating event in the beautiful new Memorial Student Center. As a fire roared in the big hearth and hot cider was politely sipped, some of you tell us you met your Graceland sweetheart while gliding across the maple hardwood of the Main Room.

A thousand roller parties, films, dances, lectures, banquets, concerts, conferences, blood drives, job fairs (and so much more) later, the MSC is still the hub of activity on campus, and quite possibly, still the place where Graceland sweethearts meet – though not while roller skating. A new, state-of-the-art wellness center might be more appealing to today's students.

Unfortunately the grand old MSC does not meet the needs of 21st century students and has likely outlived its useful life expectancy. And so quietly, behind the scenes, a dynamic and diverse committee comprised of students, faculty and staff, and alumni have been gathering facts and figures the last several months to determine what should be done.

Given the green light by President John Sellars, the 'Graceland Student Center Committee' has been methodically eyeing other colleges and universities for glimpses of their new or remodeled student centers. Committee members have made visits across the country. Chaired by alumnus Bob White '77 with Vice Chair VP for Student Life and Dean of Students Tom Powell '73, the committee has conducted focus groups with various GU constituencies and solicited opinions from alumni, students, faculty and staff. They have created an interactive Web site (gracelandforever.com) where you can take a look at myriad information, interviews, photos, committee member bios and great ideas about a possible new or improved student center. It's also easy to share your ideas on a 'Blog,' submit pictures of other structures and take a student center survey.

Completed in 1950 and expanded in 1962, our iconic MSC — dedicated to alumni who served in World War

II — has been the number-one priority of Lamoni campus master plans for a decade. Interestingly, five of the top-10, master plan projects have been completed, including our beautiful Helene Center for the Visual Arts (2004) and the just-dedicated Resch Science and Technology Hall. According to White, the committee started with the question, "Do we need a new or improved student center?" The resounding reply has been "Yes!"

"The committee has really been doing their homework on this," said White, a successful and now retired businessman from Kansas City. "We want to make sure we do it right!" Difficult decisions about whether to build new or remodel are impacted by the ultimate cost. Some small universities have built new student centers for \$20-or-30 million or more. Extreme makeovers can be undertaken for much less – perhaps in the \$10-12 million range.

The committee hopes to have planning completed and a recommendation to the GU Board of Trustees ready by May 2010. From then, with board approval, the project would move forward with speed commensurate to fundraising. Several people dedicated to Graceland are considering significant contributions to this endeavor. The first \$1million commitment to the project was just secured in early December.

Several facts are certain, White said. Prospective students and parents are not impressed by the MSC. It is expensive to heat and cool. The scattered locations of student services – located in eight buildings – are frustrating to all. In short, he said, a student center should be "…the living room of campus, a comfortable place where students can study, socialize, recreate and engage in the business of being a student." That is the goal.

Experts have been emphasizing the need for a new student center at Graceland for a decade. During that time, just in Iowa, colleges like Briar Cliff, Dordt, Cornell, Grinnell, Luther and Northwestern have built or rebuilt their student centers. White, and the committee, think it is time we pay attention and move ahead with what he calls "... one of the most exciting projects in Graceland history."



raceland Board of Trustees Chair Ken McClain was speaking at the Alumni Forum at Homecoming when he said, "We are living through interesting times." How right he is. We have all been challenged by these interesting and difficult times resulting from a world economic crisis that has affected every nation, institution, business and individual. Graceland has been impacted as well.

Introducing this 2009 Annual Report, however, I take stock that we are weathering the fiscal crisis well even though we did experience a deficit. Through necessary streamlining across our campuses, lowering the tuition discount rate and reenergizing new-student recruitment, we have confronted these interesting times, we are emerging as a stronger institution than we were a year ago and we anticipate balanced budgets in the future.

We have just experienced the second-best fundraising year in our history. Enrollment figures look very hopeful. The university is on a sound financial footing. We are poised to continue moving forward, engaging the crisis in proactive ways. Some streamlining decisions have indeed been painful, but we have responded to these program and personnel changes as a community. Together, we have diligently pursued cost cutting measures wherever possible, taking great care to maintain the high academic quality our students deserve.

We have kept students informed as we reviewed a number of programs and made some changes. We have informed students that our recommended tuition increase for next year is far less than other private and public universities. We are conscious that everybody has been impacted by the economy and aware of the financial pressures faced by Graceland families.

This has not been an easy year for anyone, but as a community we are moving forward and I anticipate better times ahead. Thank you for your continued support. I appreciate your loyalty to Graceland. If you have a question, please feel free to give me a call at 641.784.5112.





Use of Funds in thousands Total......35,883.... 100.0%




